Make music with scallop shell castanets!

YOU WILL NEED

- White paper plates
- String
- Scissors
- Paper and a pencil
- Plastic lids, bottle tops or buttons
- Eco glue
- Paints and paintbrushes
- A grown-up to help

WOW!
Scallops swim by clapping their shells quickly!

7 Make two holes in the middle of the shell. Thread string through and tie it firmly.

8 Stick plastic lids, bottle tops, or buttons to the inside and see which will make the best noise!

1 Draw a shell shape on paper. Ask a grown-up to help you cut it out.

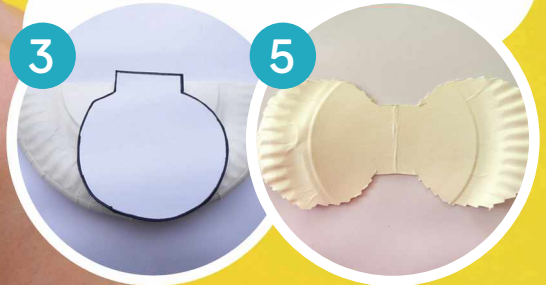
2 Fold a paper plate in half, pressing down the fold as you go.

3 Lay the paper shell on the plate so the narrow part is on the fold.

4 Draw round your template. Add a squiggly edge to the shell.

5 Ask a grown-up to cut out the shell, stopping at the fold so it stays in one piece.

6 Decorate your shell any way you like!
